- **3. Public and Venue Safety:** Ensure all meeting venues, accommodations are complied with health, emergency and safety policies and regulations and well equipped with required resources.
- **4. Operational Continuity:** Maintain health emergency and security response agencies regular services and operations without interruption while providing full support for the CHOGM.
- **5. Community Engagement:** Keep the community informed to ensure they are fully aware of changes in health emergency and security services provision from time to time during CHOGM.

- Lead agency in medical and public health emergency response prior, during and after CHOGM
- Ensure the CHOGM Ward, health facilities and medical clinics in CHOGM meeting venues are fully equipped with required resources including the staff.
- Work hand in hand with CHOGM Health Emergency and Security Command Post when assistance is needed pertaining health.

### DISASTER MANAGEMENT OFFICE

- Lead agency in disaster and emergency management and response.
- Oversee the implementation of disaster and emergency response when declared as State of Emergency during CHOGM
- Activate NEOC when State of Emergency is declared during CHOGM

### MINISTRY OF POLICE, PRISONS AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES

- Lead agency in provision of security services within all CHOGM premises including meeting venues and accommodations
- Control traffic

### SAMOA FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICES AUTHORITY

- Lead agency in providing emergency response services prior, during and after CHOGM.
- Facilitate and coordinate the running of ambulance services for CHOGM Ward, and all CHOGM meeting venues and accommodations.




